Fishing at Segundo Muelle

In this opportunity we show our lack of experience in the culinary world with our humble review of this restaurant we visited a couple of weeks ago.

Segundo Muelle is a peruvian franchise offering mostly seafood-oriented dishes.

This author decided to try something new, which is why I ordered the Tacu-tacu with spicy seafood sauce.

Guided only by menu illustrations, a member of our party decided to ask about this dish and the brief description given was that it was "kind of like a tamal", but with rice.

Actually, that's how I felt at first when I got my plate, although different I enjoyed it very much. Later I found out from a peruvian friend that the Tacu-tacu has as a main ingredient beans. I also learned about chinese food influence over peruvian food.

Among other dishes they had different combinations of pasta and seafood. Usually this pasta is offered with different sauces, but that night some of them weren't available. I didn't hear any negative or positive critics about those, but I could definitely remember the large portion of pasta served on each dish.

Lastly, leaving a mark on my inexperience writing this kind of article, I would like to share a bit about the entrees, from which we had some pork-filled wanton, fried plantain and yuca with dips, and a restaurants specialty consisting on three kinds of cebiches which deserves a try since it is different from the usual national recipe.



We had, overall, a good experience. The plates took some time to arrive, but the special ocassion would let this slip. The place was mostly empty when we got there, but filled completely later, so reservations are necessary. The dishes can be around the \$13 to \$20+ range. Given their localization it's a good thing they offer valet service. The restaurant is located in San Francisco a their phone number is (507) 391-9234. They've got a website with their menu, but at the time of this post, Google shows it as possibly containing malware.
